1. SPONSOR: Family News Summit, 12138 Central Avenue, Suite 255, Mitchellville, Md 20721 ("Mail Address"), is solely responsible for all aspects of this contest ("Contest").

2. BRIEF OVERVIEW OF CONTEST: This is a Contest to be conducted during the period commencing at 12:01 A.M, November 1, 2009, and ending at 11:59:59 P.M., February 1, 2010 ("Entry Period") as a competition to select winning entries from among those Contestants submitting entries via <http://FamilyNewsSummit.com> ("Website").

For the Contest submissions should consist of the following elements:

- **Family News Summit Teacher of the Year**[1] one letter, up to 500 words per school level, elementary, middle schools, high schools and colleges, located in the Washington Metropolitan area (MD, DC, VA) only. One letter for one teacher stating "Why you have nominated this teacher to be recognized as teacher of the Year.  
[2] one 60 second Video of the nominee answering the following question:  
**Teachers will answer:** "Why do I want to be a Teacher?"
- **Family News Summit Student of the Year**[1] one letter, up to 500 words per school level, elementary, middle schools, high schools and colleges, located in the Washington Metropolitan area (MD, DC, VA) only. One letter for one student stating "Why you have nominated this student to be recognized as student of the year.  
[2] For College student ONLY -one 60 second Video of the nominee  
[3] For Grade school student ONLY – one letter per child up to 250 words  
Both are answering the following question:  
**Students will answer,** "Why is it important to give to others?"
- **Family News Summit Family Business of the Year**[1] one letter up to 500 words per family stating "Why this Family Business should be recognized as the FNS Family Business of the Year"[2] one 60 second Video of the family answering the question: "Why is it important to support the Community that supports your family business?"**Family News Summit Family of the Year**[1] one letter up to 500 words per family stating "Why your family should be recognized as the FNS Family of the Year"[2] one 60 second Video of the family answering the question: "Why is the Family unit important to the growth of a positive community?" The Community will

vote for the winner from each category for teacher, student, family business of the Year Awards. Family News Summit will select the Family of the Year Award. Selections will be made from all the contest entries sent to "[ContestEntry@FamilyNewsSummit.com](mailto:ContestEntry@FamilyNewsSummit.com)." Transportation, lodging or meals will not be provided to any of the winners or contestants. For purposes of these Official Rules ("Rules"), "Day" shall mean each calendar day during the Entry Period and all times and Days are Eastern Daylight Time. The awarding of the prize is subject to the eligibility and forfeiture provisions set forth below.

3. ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for this Contest, at the time of entering, the Contestant must be: [1] a natural person legally residing in, and physically located within, Washington Metropolitan Area, (MD, DC, VA) for the Teacher and Student of the Year Contest.
